Dearest Friends,

We are almost done with the first month of 2016. Let us make it a bumper year for witnessing to people about the saving grace of the Lord Jesus.

In order to do that we ourselves have to be spending more time with Him and in the Word. It is His Word in us that carries the power. We think that skipping out on reading the Word as long as we pray on our way to work will suffice but Jesus IS the Word and was made manifest in the flesh, not only so that He could die on the Cross but also so that He would be the example that we could follow. His relationship and communication with the Father was amazing:

"Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the son likewise." John 5:16

If it was good for Him then how much more does it apply to us?

For many years I have pondered on the anointing. We talk about how mightily anointed this preacher or that preacher is and then find out that all the while they have been in sin and we glibly repeat the scripture,

"For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance."

And herein lies the problem. We confuse the gifting with the anointing. We talk about how well this preacher or that preacher knows the Word but the devil is extremely well versed in the Word and when we lack discernment he is very well able to use the situation to deceive. If there is one thing that the Body of Christ is lacking in these days it is discernment and we need to be asking God for a double dose of discernment even as Solomon asked for wisdom.

"The **gifts** are without repentance....." God endows us with **gifts**. I have been given the **gift** of hospitality. I love to have people come and visit and take great delight in preparing elaborate meals for them? Am I able to that even if I were in sin – of course!

One of my favorite Gospel singers was **gifted** by God with the most wonderful songs – he has to be one of the most **gifted** psalmists of our time. He is heavily involved in sin and will not get help and deliverance but can he still sing and move me emotionally – of course. We get our emotions confused with the anointing. Others are **gifted** in oratory and this is often accompanied by charisma. They say all the right things

go to a conference and hear a charismatic orator and his oration is followed by signs and wonders. We go home believing we have been to the most wonderfully anointed service ever. In actual fact there was no anointing from the pulpit but only a **gifting** in operation.... "the **gifts** are without repentance." The devil can move in, making it extremely charismatic and one of the "tells" will often be in who ultimately gets the glory.

God's people go to these conferences because they are hungry and He will not let them down. "Signs and wonders accompany the Word." The signs and wonders follow even when the vessel is full of sin.

The Bible tells us that even the elect are going to be deceived in the end days and we are beginning to see more and more of this happening in the church today. This is why it is so important for God's people to have discernment more than ever before.

When we hear or see something in church we need to go home and confirm it with the Word. If the Word does not confirm it then we need to put it on the shelf. It is like having someone prophesy over you. A personal prophecy should only confirm something that God has already been speaking to you through the Word. We are too lazy to find out for ourselves. This is why so many lives are in a mess and we, as the church are not the witness to the lost and dying that we should be.

It is time for us to stand up and be the church – the light of the world and the salt of the earth and to hell literal with all of this politically correct stuff. Either God is God and His Word is TRUTH or we can be politically correct and denigrate the message of the Gospel. MINISTRY NEEDS

Thank you for the bicycles. The staff is thrilled and it will save so much money and time. They will be able to cycle from place to place instead of walking or taking a minibus. I will have a photo in the next issue.

We do need two 125cc motorcycles in the near future. Of course these are a lot more expensive so if 10 people would be willing to give \$80 that would cover the cost of the motorcycles.

With the reports on the hunger of the local people in Tengani to have prayer meetings and church we need to pursue the building. We are considering structural steel since it will withstand any termites in the area and Tengani is notorious for termites. We will have to import the structure from South Africa. In The next issue I will have a costing for that along with the size of the building which will not only act as a church but also a counseling center and a place of refuge when flooding comes and that area seems prone to either flooding or drought. That is what happens when we destroy the eco systems of an area and Malawi has decimated its forests for firewood in order to cook their food.

Please keep these projects in prayer. We know that God ultimately is our source but He works through you and me. To quote the famous missionary. Hudson Taylor: "God's work done Gods way will never lack God supply."

If the finances are not available for certain tasks then it may be that it is not God's timing for that project. Sometimes He wants us to keep things simple and we overreach. Ultimately it is He that builds His Kingdom using people who are willing vessels. In the meanwhile church will be held under the nearest available tree. We do have a school opposite the land and I have asked them to check to see if we can use one of their buildings.
